- 1) To download the app you will need a Japanese google account. Now seems to be a good time to mention this guide is for android only. Luckily a Japanese google account has been created and made available to you. Sign in with the following information.

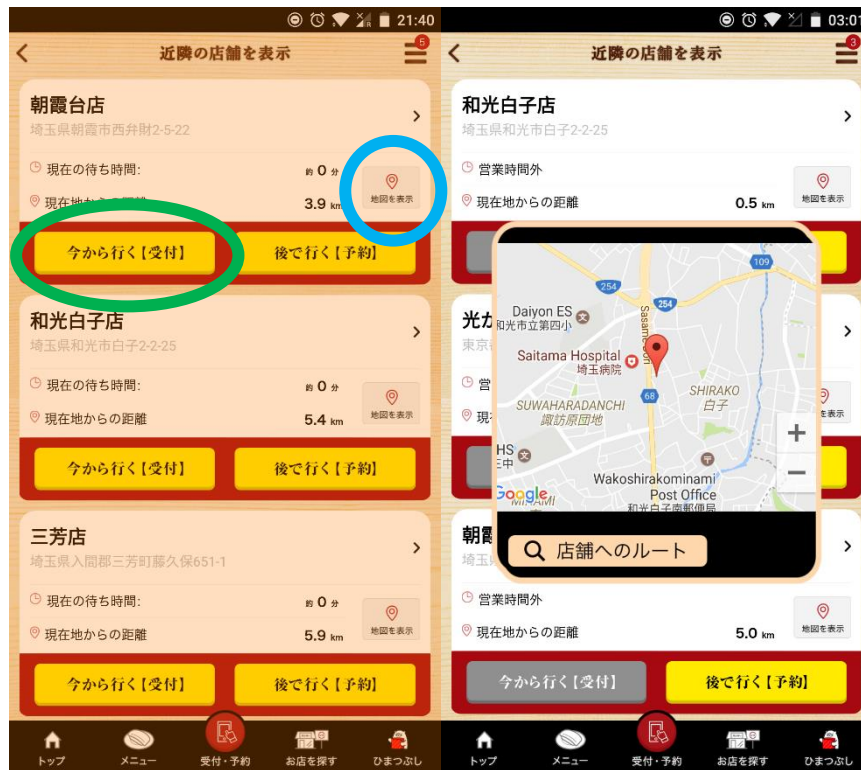

- 2) Download the app. Follow the link on <http://www.akindo-sushiro.co.jp/en/>
Or go direct to the play store with at https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=jp.co.akindo_sushiro.sushiroapp
Or just search sushiro. Not tested this method

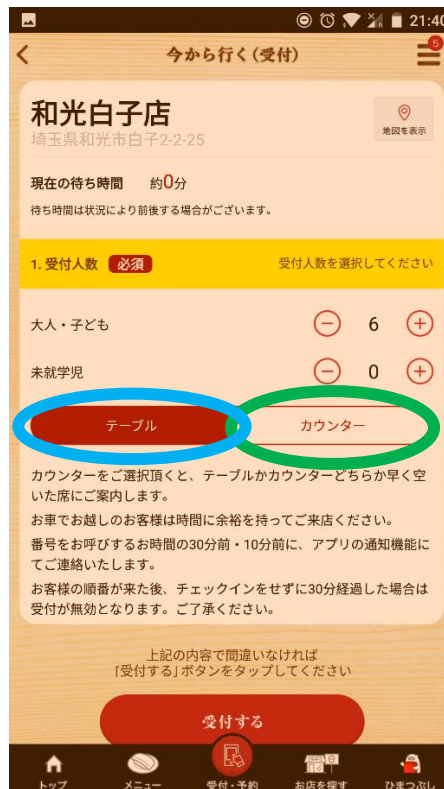
- 3) Once installed comes the tricky part, using it. Upon opening the app you will be faced with this screen. Click the green highlighted button to begin the process.



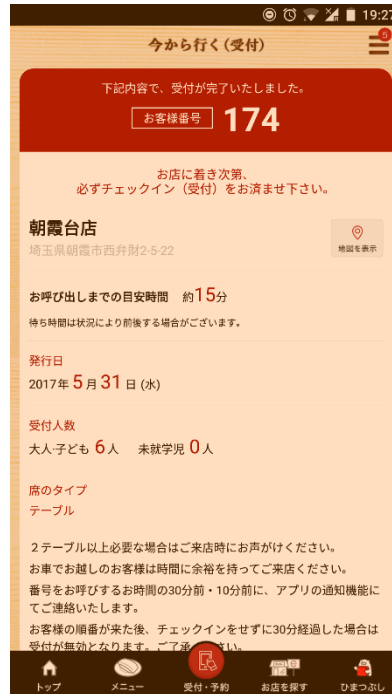
- 4) Select a restaurant using the button circled in green. You can check it is the right one using the button highlighted in blue. Be careful you don't end up in Asaka.



- 5) Top number is amount of adults. Bottom is children. Button highlighted in blue is for a table. Button in green is for a counter. Red number at top currently 0 is the estimated wait in minutes from now. Press the red button at the bottom to enter.



- 6) You will then be given a screen like this. The top number is your number. When you get to the restaurant you will need to enter this number. I recommend having google translate on your phone with live translate set up as this makes navigating the menus a lot easier in the restaurant. Once you have entered in the restaurant wait for your number to be called.



If you have any issues when running this app I recommend taking a screenshot of the page you are at. You can then use google translate to translate the screen shot by using the button, highlighted in green, in the image translate page.
